The attitudes and temperament of the Balinese reflect this sense of security. Every act must be in harmony with the natural forces which hold supreme sway over the island. Although each male citizen with a family generally owns the land he labors and live on, theoretically the island is divine property leased to the people who cultivate it and live from it.

The Temple is the most important institution in Bali and the center of Balinese religious activities. Renowned as the "Land of One Thousand Temple", there are actually at least 50,000 scattered all over the island. Large or small, simple or elaborately carved, they are everywhere. In houses, courtyards, marketplaces, cemeteries, rice paddies, beaches, in arid scrub land, on barren rocks offshore, on deserted hilltops and mountain heights, deep inside caves, within the tangled roots of banyan trees. Bali has diverse landscape that ranges from magnificent white sandy beaches and fertile rice fields to rugged volcanoes. Bali also offers a chance to discover one of the world's fascinating culture; rich in art, sculpture, dance, religion, tradition, and genuine nature.
